Leaves collected 2nd & 4th week each month through March 12

- Leaf-Vac is used;
 DO NOT bag
- Leaves must be in Town's right of way but not in gutter
- Leaves must be out for pick up by Monday night

Limbs collected 1st & 3rd week each month

- Max Length 10 feet Max Width 8 inches No Stumps
- No pick up for debris cut by a paid individual/ lawn service company – owner responsible
- Limbs must be placed in Town's right of way but not in the street
- Limbs must be out for pick up by Monday night
