The Police Chief ensures effective operations, preparedness, and training levels and identifies opportunities to implement improvements. The role requires an individual with the ability to communicate a vision and clarify the department's mission while leading and inspiring confidence among officers.

- Demonstrated ability to lead and direct the activities of Police Department staff.
- Possesses a considerable knowledge base that includes state and federal laws, local ordinances, and the principles, practices, methods, rules and regulations relating to criminal justice and law enforcement administration.
- Maintains cutting edge knowledge of scientific methods for crime detection, criminal identification, and radio communication.
- Effective in managing subordinates through team building, counseling, coaching, motivating, communicating, and evaluating performance.
- Skilled in establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with other Town officials, law enforcement agencies, employees, and the general public.
- Ability to act with sound judgement in routine and emergency situations.
- Experienced in various facets of policing including using firearms and other police equipment, applying self-defense tactics, and preparing and reviewing reports.

- Possession of an Advanced Law Enforcement Certificate issued by the North Carolina Justice Training and Standards Commission; instructor certification preferred.
- Graduation from an accredited community college with a degree in criminal justice or public
 administration supplemented by basic and advanced courses in police science and administration and
 considerable managerial law enforcement experience of an increasingly responsible nature; or an
 equivalent combination of education and experience.

The Town of Granite Quarry, located in Rowan County, is 45 miles northeast of Charlotte via I-85. Home to over 2,900 residents, Granite Quarry offers a unique, small-town charm within a growing metropolitan region. Our walkable sidewalks connect to parks, schools, our downtown area and the Carolina Thread Trail. Residents and visitors enjoy our family-friendly activities and events such as Granite Fest, our annual signature festival. In addition to the various amenities within our community, Granite Quarry is also just a short drive from nearby attractions such as the Charlotte Motor Speedway, North Carolina Transportation Museum and minor league baseball.

In recent years, the Town has set strategic goals focused on ensuring a high quality of life and expanding opportunities. We have also adopted several plans to guide growth and community enhancements, including the 2040 Comprehensive Land Use Plan, Downtown Master Plan, Parks & Recreation Master Plan and Bicycle & Pedestrian Plan.

Town Government

The Town operates under a council-manager form of government and is comprised of a Mayor and a four-member Town Council, who are elected at-large for four-year staggered terms. The Town has four departments: Administration, Police, Fire, and Public Works. The Town staff includes a total of 61 positions, 24 of which are full-time employees.
